BYLAW NO 02-2017

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF SPEED BUMPS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEILBURG

The Council of the Village of Neilburg in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Short Title:

This bylaw shall be referred to as the Speed Bump Bylaw

2. Definitions:

In this bylaw:

- a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the Municipality;
- b) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Municipality;
- c) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Neilburg;
- d) "Speed Bump" means an uneven patch of the road constructed of asphalt, concrete or other like material for the purpose of controlling speed;
- e) "Signage" means the signs erected indicating the speed bump ahead
- f) "School Zone" means the North West School Division

3. Purpose:

- 1. Council will use speed bumps for the safety of pedestrians in specified areas as seen fit, and will do so by resolution for specific areas.
- 2. Signage will be erected indicating speed bump ahead.
- 3. The speed bumps will be installed in the designated areas as follows:
 - Two sets through the school zone
 - Two sets on Railway Ave intersected with 4th Street East

Coming into Force

This Bylaw shall come into Force on October 10th, 2017.
