## VILLAGE OF NEILBURG

## **BYLAW 2, 2011**

## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER METERS.

The Council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: -

- 1] In this bylaw:
  - a) "Village" means Village of Neilburg
- 2] Scope of the Bylaw:
  - a) Water meters shall be installed in every connection to the municipal water distribution system.
  - b) Persons desiring to be supplied with water from the municipal system must make application to the Administrator of the municipality. Each application shall be accompanied by payment of those charges set out in Schedule "A".
  - c) Every person shall provide at his/her own expense a place in his/her premises for the installation of the meter. The meter location must be acceptable to the Public Works Department and shall provide ready and easy means of access to the said meter for examination by the meter reader. Every consumer shall at all times properly and efficiently protect the service pipes and fixtures from frost or other injury so that the meter shall not in any way be damaged.
  - d) Water meters shall remain the property of the municipality.
- 3] Infraction of the Bylaw:
  - a) Any person who willfully damages or tampers with or breaks the seal on any meter shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
  - b) Any person who obstructs or refuses to admit authorized servants or agents of the Village to have free access at proper hours of the day and upon reasonable notice given, and or request made, to all parts of the premises in which water is delivered, for the purpose of inspections or repairing any service pipe or for the placing of meters he deems expedient and for the purpose of protecting or regulating the use of any meter shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.

4] Penalty

a) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw if guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
