REPEALING BYLAW

A BYLAW TO REPEAL BYLAWS NO. 3, 8, 9A, 40, 43, 50, 56, 70, 73, 75, 134, 170, 176, 200, 1/2006 and 2/2006

The Council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: -

- 1] Bylaw No. 3 to provide for the enforcement of the Bylaws of the Village passed January 27, 1947 and approved on February 22, 1947, is hereby repealed.
- 2] Bylaw No. 8 to prevent the encumbrance or obstruction of roads, streets, sidewalks and lanes by vehicles or other articles or things passed on January 27, 1947 and approved on February 22, 1947, is hereby repealed.
- 3] Bylaw No. 9A to repeal a bylaw authorizing the council to provide for medical care for residents of the municipality passed on November 8, 1949, is hereby repealed.
- 4] Bylaw 40 authorizing the expenditure of \$33,541.67 for the purpose of paying the cost of the local improvements passed October 20, 1965, is hereby repealed.
- 5] Bylaw No. 43 for establishing a Park and Recreation Board or (Recreation Board) passed May 23, 1967, is hereby repealed.
- Bylaw No. 50 for the purpose of giving approval to an agreement to further develop, operate and continue a regional park under the provisions of the Regional Parks Act passed December 3, 1971, is hereby repealed.
- 7] Bylaw No. 56 to repeal Bylaw No. 6 regulating the speed of motor vehicles passed August 4, 1972, is hereby repealed.
- Bylaw No. 70 to exempt the Neilburg PSCO from taxation passed April 6, 1978, is hereby repealed.
- 9] Bylaw No. 73 to regulate plumbing and drainage and the disposal of sewage within the Village of Neilburg passed on May 3, 1979, is hereby repealed.
- 10] Bylaw No. 75 to provide for entering into an agreement respecting the joint funding of certain recreation facilities passed November 1, 1979, is hereby repealed.
- 11] Bylaw No. 134 authorizing financial contribution in the Regional Park Authority of Suffern Lake to the Regional Parks Act, 1979 passed July 4, 1988, is hereby repealed.
- 12] Bylaw No. 170 to provide that businesses are not to be assessed passed April 7, 1997, is hereby repealed.
- 13] Bylaw No. 176 to remove abandoned vehicles passed January 12, 1998, is hereby repealed.
- Bylaw No. 200 to control the disposal of scrap tires passed May 3, 2004, is hereby repealed.

- 15] Bylaw 1, 2006 to provide for entering into an agreement respecting the provision for the use of mill rate factors and/or an adjusted school mill rate passed June 5, 2006, is hereby repealed.
- Bylaw 2, 2006 to provide for minimum amount of tax passed June 5, 2006, is hereby repealed.
