

Bylaw No. 60

A BYLAW TO EXTEND THE NEILBURG AIRPORT

WHEREAS the Village of Neilburg wishes to extend the existing Neilburg Airport, (hereinafter referred to as "the said airport") and;

WHEREAS, HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN has granted financial assistance by way of a contribution towards the cost of the work of developing and improving the said airport, such contribution not to exceed, in any event, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00);

AND WHEREAS, the Village of Neilburg agrees to develop the said airport in accordance with plans and specifications submitted by the Minister of Transport and operate and maintain the said airport as a public airport:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1) That the Village of Neilburg enter into an agreement with HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, being amended Agreement No. 93788, for the purpose of developing the said airport in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Department of Transport and in accordance with the provisions of the Aeronautics Act, being Chapter A-3 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1970.
- 2) Bylaw 55, passed June 22, 1972, is hereby repealed.
